**Easy Street and A357 High Street (Southbound), Templecombe**  
**(Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles and Lane Closure) Order 2019**

Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and after giving notice to the Chief Officer of Police, hereby makes the following Order: -

This Order will come into operation on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of October 2019 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The effect of which will be to introduce a temporary prohibition of vehicles in the roads specified in schedule 1 to this Order and a temporary lane closure on the road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order. The works are expected to take place on the 13<sup>th</sup> November 2019 for 1 day, the restrictions will only apply when indicated by traffic signs.

**Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles**

<b>Easy Street, Templecombe</b>	From its junction with East Street to its junction with High Street for its entire length a distance of 20 metres.

**Schedule 2**  
**Temporary Lane Closure**

<b>A357 High Street, (southbound) Templecombe</b>	From a point 160 metres south of its junction with Samuel Court to its junction with Easy Street a distance of 50 metres in a southerly direction.

- a) because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road;

- b) because of the likelihood of danger to the public, or of serious damage to the road, which is not attributable to such works.
